

The program aims to offer a rigorous education with academic and practical tools and know-how in order to achieve success in international financial markets.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The courses take place from October to June. The program offers two different tracks.

The non-thesis track gives the opportunity to participate this learning experience without giving up their current activities. A typical non-thesis student takes four core courses and six electives and writes a graduation project in the last semester.

Students who aim an academic career path take four core courses, three electives and a seminar course, After they complete the coursework they are expected to write a thesis in their last year.
